- ❖ What is Credit Recovery?
 - Credit Recovery is.....
 - ◆ A way to get back on track
 - ◆ A way to help YOU graduate from your home school
 - ◆ A system that allows individuals who have failed a subject to become successful in that subject.
 - ◆ Transferable to your home school even if not finished while at RTF

- ❖ Is it Right for Me?
 - CR (Credit Recovery) targets students in grades 9-12 who have previously failed courses which will not allow them to graduate on time with a High School diploma.
 - If you have failed a required class for graduation with a score between 50-69% then..... YES!!

- ❖ How Does CR Work?
 - CR Uses a Digital Curriculum
 - ◆ PLATO technology will be utilized for instruction, assessment, and student management.
 - ◆ Instruction is self-paced and self-directed.
 - CR uses Extended Learning Time
 - ◆ CR focuses in on the skills NOT YET mastered.
 - ◆ CR is based upon your PRIOR knowledge.
 - ◆ CR assessments are based upon your progress in YOUR learning.

- ❖ What do I Need to Do?
 - Pick up an Application Package in Guidance or on line.
 - ◆ Complete the application including Parent Signatures.
 - ◆ Arrange to meet with Your Principal.
 - ◆ Return completed forms to Your Guidance Counselor.
 - Make Adequate Progress
 - ◆ Abide by all procedures in the PLATO Lab.
 - ◆ Attain Mastery (80%) on EVERY examination.
 - Come Prepared
 - ◆ Paper, Pencil, Pen
 - Complete End of Program Survey for each course recovered.
