

Credit Recovery General Policy Statement

Credit Recovery at R. T. Fisher School is a program which gives students in grades 9-12 the opportunity to regain credit in a required course they have previously failed. These credits will be recovered by showing mastery of state curriculum standards in the Plato digital curriculum. Eligible students will be allowed to work in a supervised school setting during their physical enrichment time. Upon successful completion of the Plato coursework the student will receive a standard credit, with a grade no higher than a "C", recorded on their transcript. Should a student complete the program at R.T. Fisher before completing their credit recovery, they will have to complete the credit in a supervised before or after school setting at their home school.
